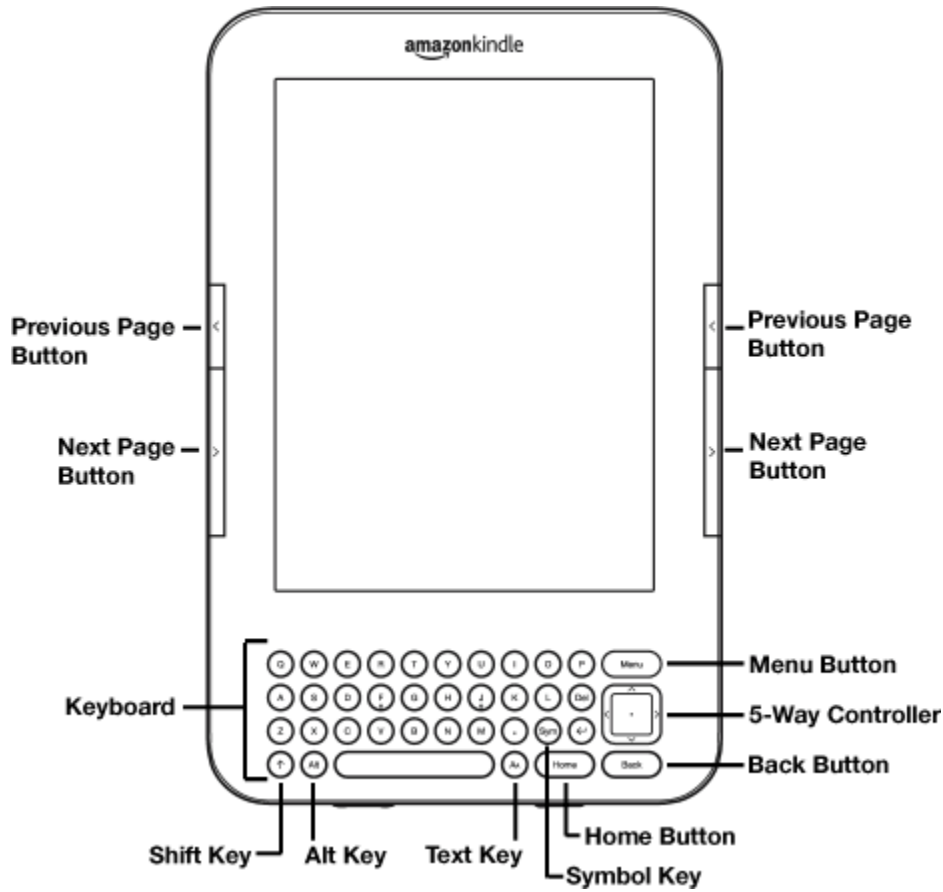

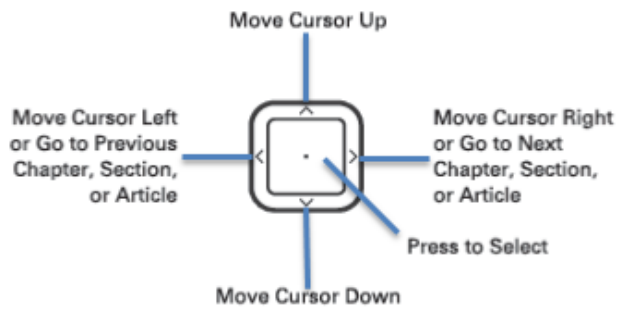

The Buttons on a Kindle:

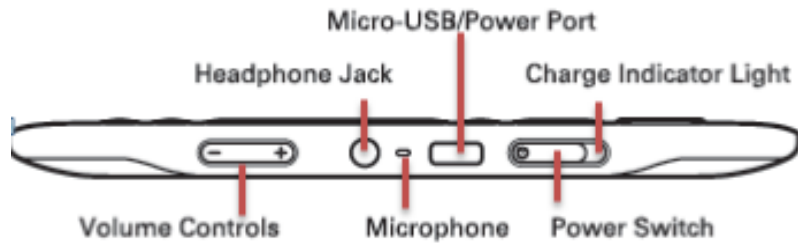
Front View:

Help for Kindle:

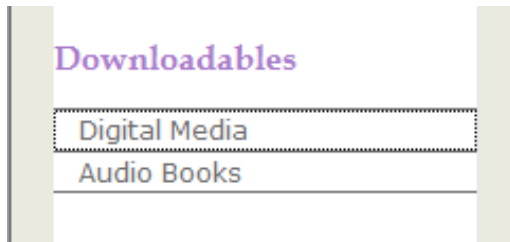

Downloading E-Books for a Kindle from the Library:

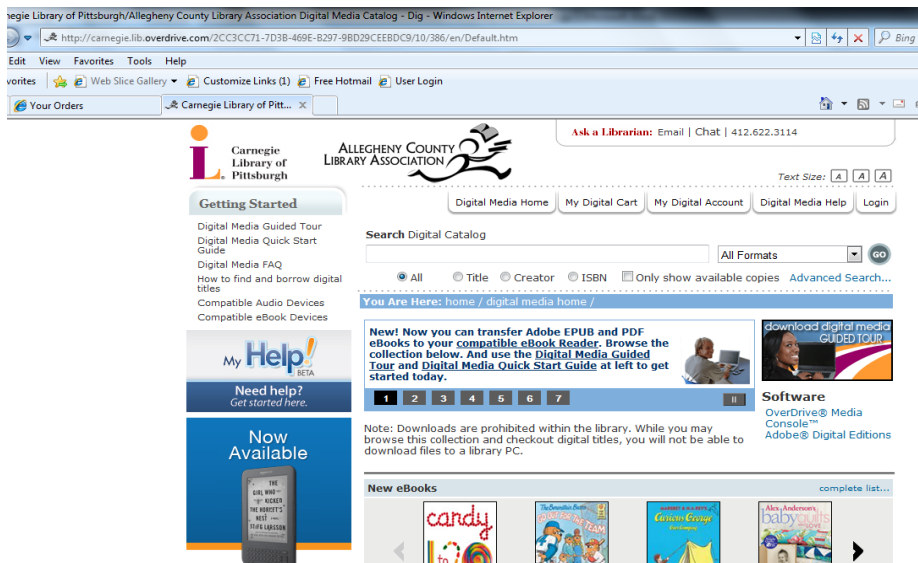
Downloading e-books for your Kindle is free and can be done from a library computer

Step 1: Access Overdrive, the digital book repository

Under Downloadables on the Baldwin Borough Library Website, click Digital Media



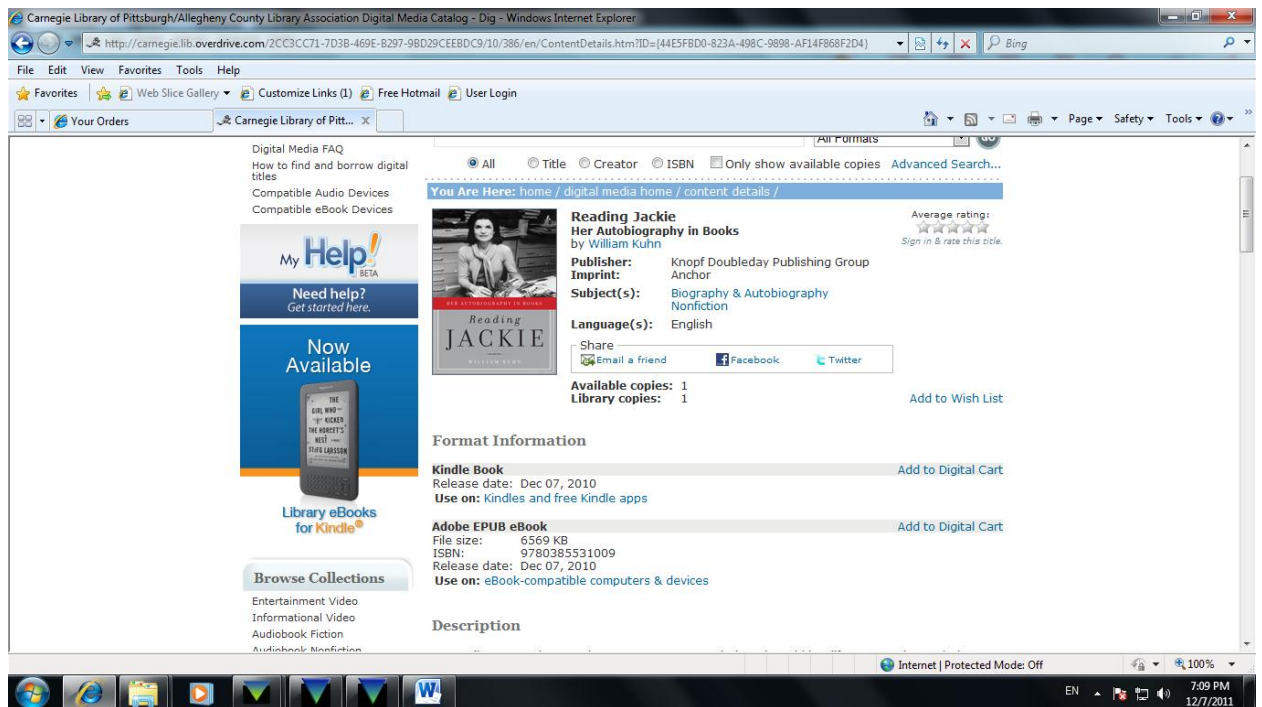
The digital book download site looks like this:



Step 2: Select an e-book.

You can search for an e-book using the search bar. You can limit the e-book format (ex. only Kindle e-books) using the drop down menu next to the search bar.

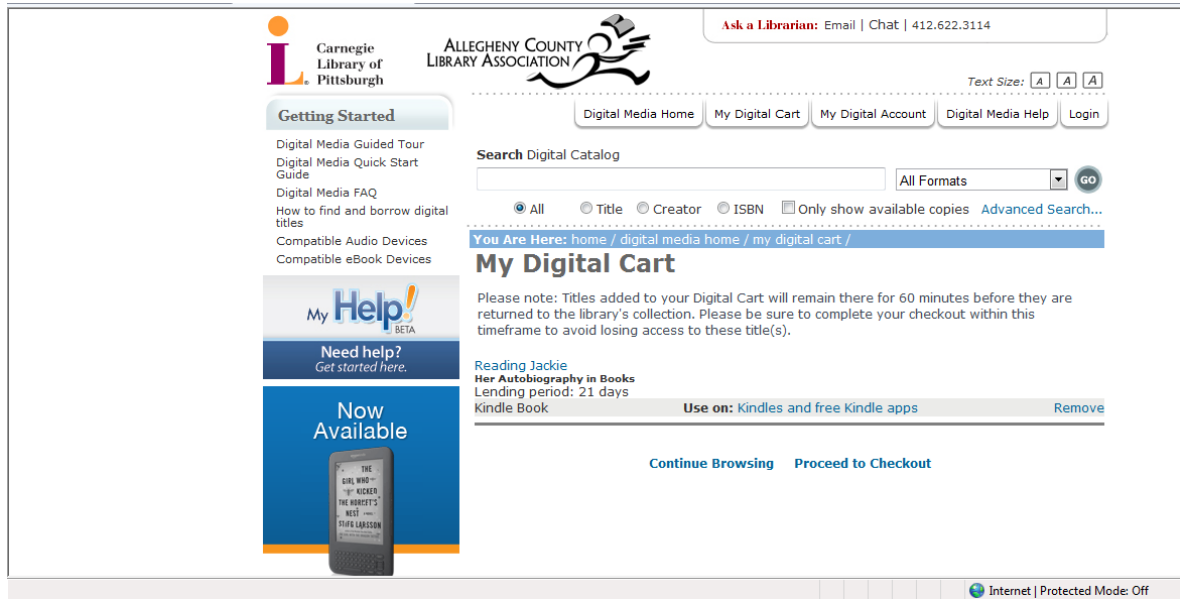
If the book is not check out it will say **Add to Digital Cart**. Only one copy of a digital book can be downloaded at one time. An available digital book page will look like this:



Step 3: Checking out on Overdrive

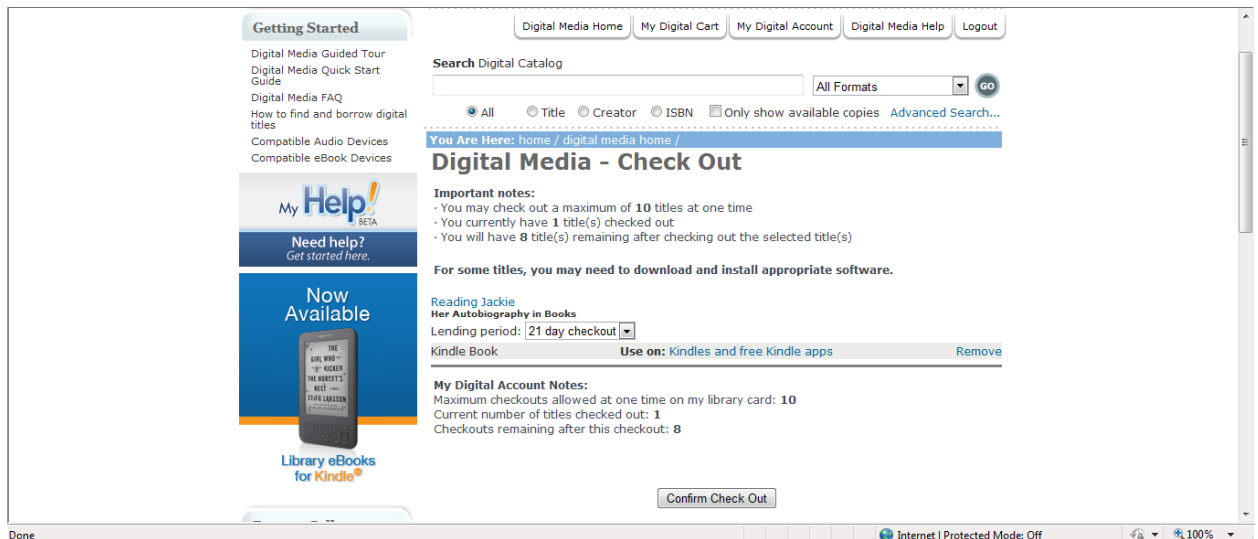
To check out the book, select **Add to Digital Cart**. If you own a Kindle, you will need to select the **Add to Digital Cart** button next to the label Kindle Book. Not all books are Kindle compatible.

Your Digital Cart page will look like this:



If you are finished selecting books, click the **Proceed to Checkout** button. If not, click on the **Continue Browsing** button

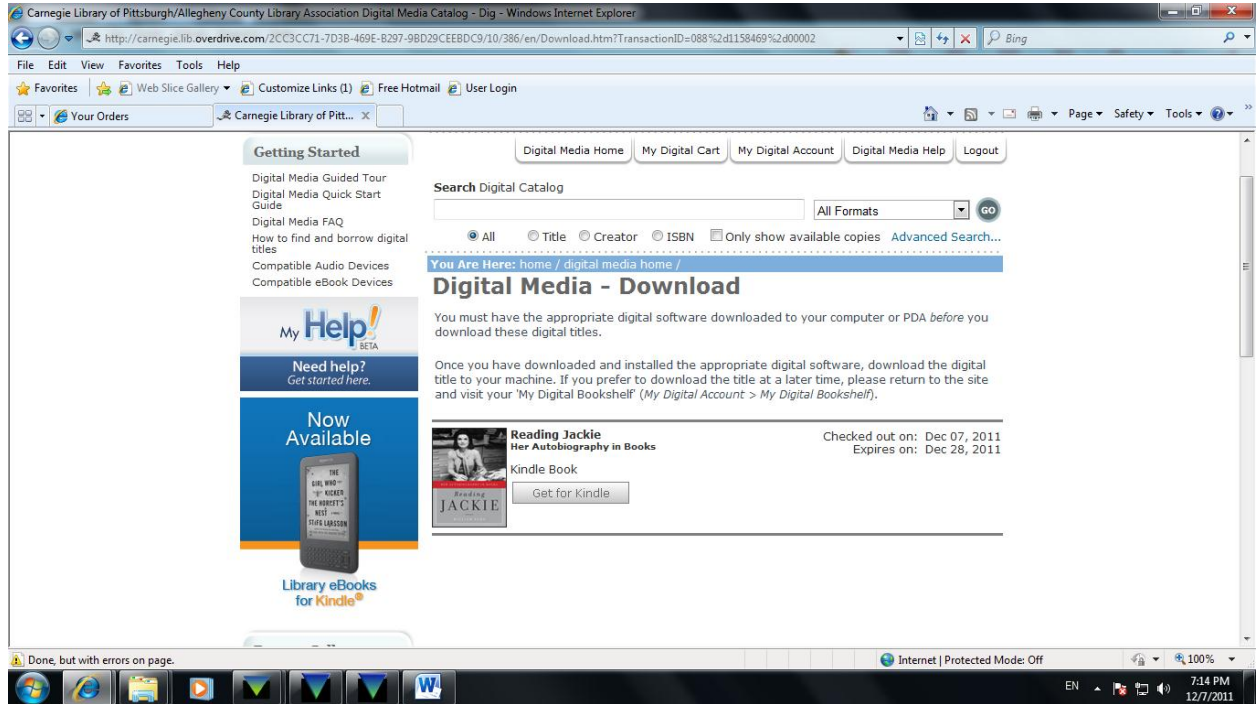
When you checkout, you will need to enter your library card number. The **Checkout Page** looks like this:



Select confirm checkout.

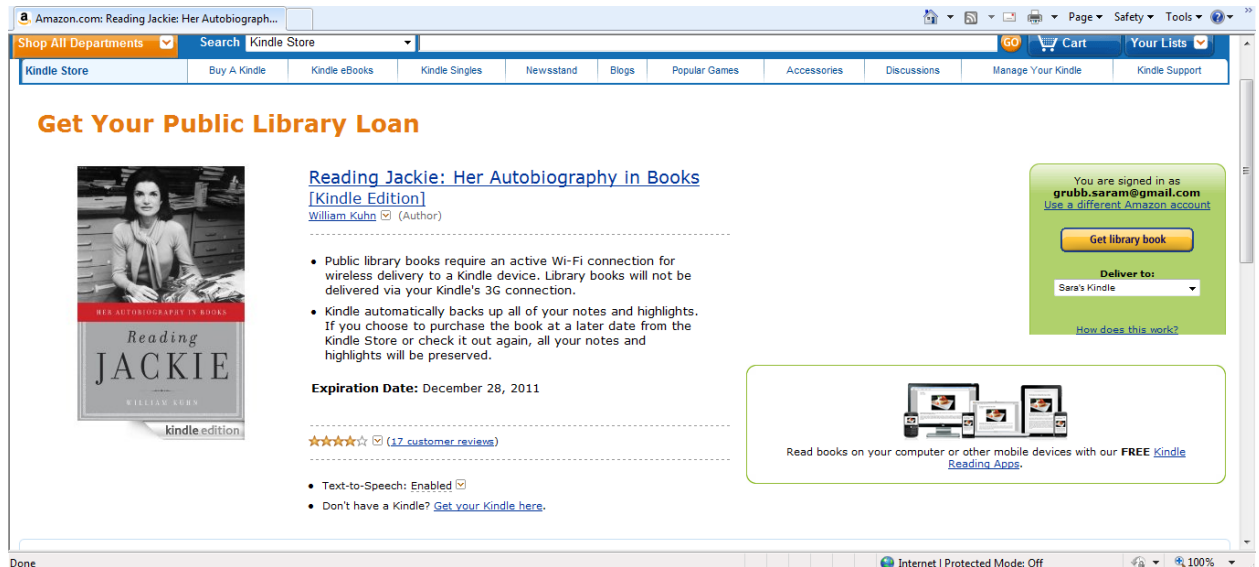
Step 4: Putting your e-book on your Kindle

When you checkout a Kindle e-book, the download page will look like this:



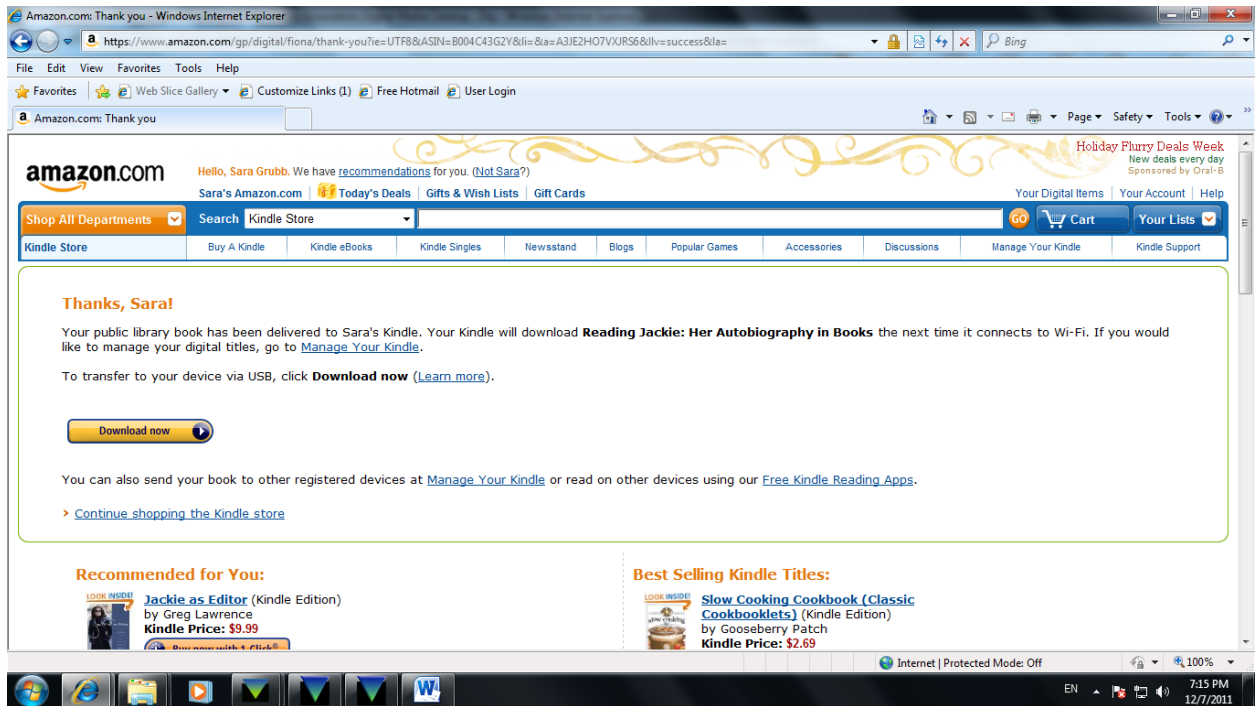
Select the **Get for Kindle** button, which will take you to the Amazon.com page for that book.

That page looks like this:



Select the **Get Library Book** button. You will need to be signed into your Amazon.com account.

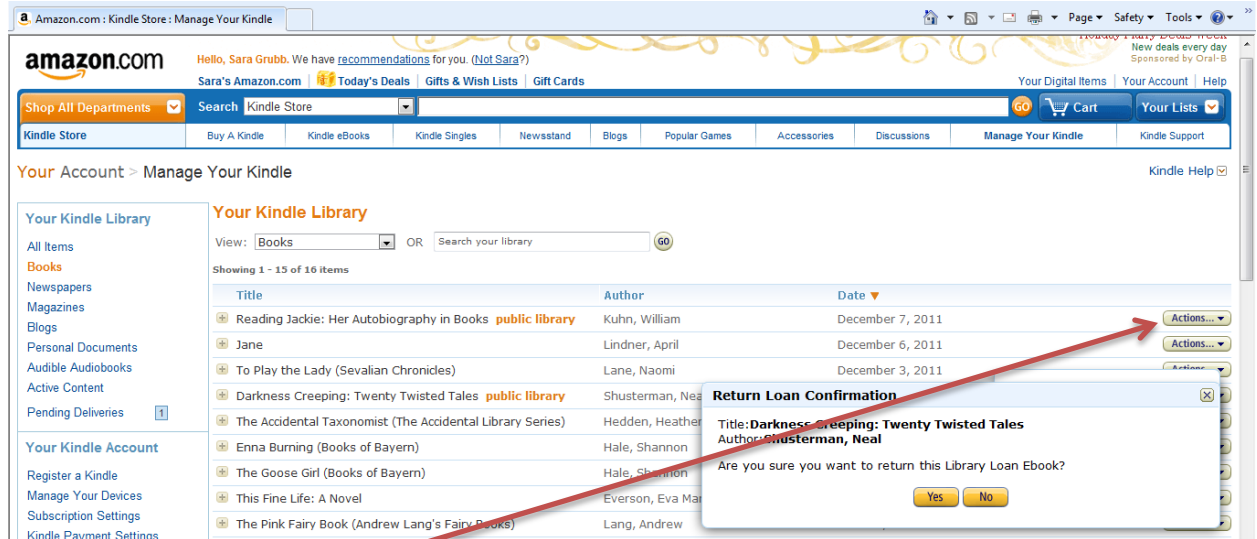
The resulting page will look like this:



If you have wireless internet on your Kindle, the book will be delivered to your Kindle through the internet. If not, select the **Download Now** button. This will download a digital copy of the book to your computer, which you can add to your Kindle by connecting your Kindle to your computer with its USB cord.

Returning a Kindle Library Book Early:

Go to **Your Account** on Amazon.com (not your library account) and Select **Manage Your Kindle**, which is under the subheading **Digital Content** on the **Your Account** page. Your Kindle Library looks like this:



To return a book, press the **Actions** button next to the desired book and press the **Return This Book** button. A message confirming the loan return will appear (see above) select yes.

YOU WILL NEVER GET AN OVERDUE BOOK FINE FOR A DIGITAL BOOK:

Books will automatically expire at the end of your loan period
