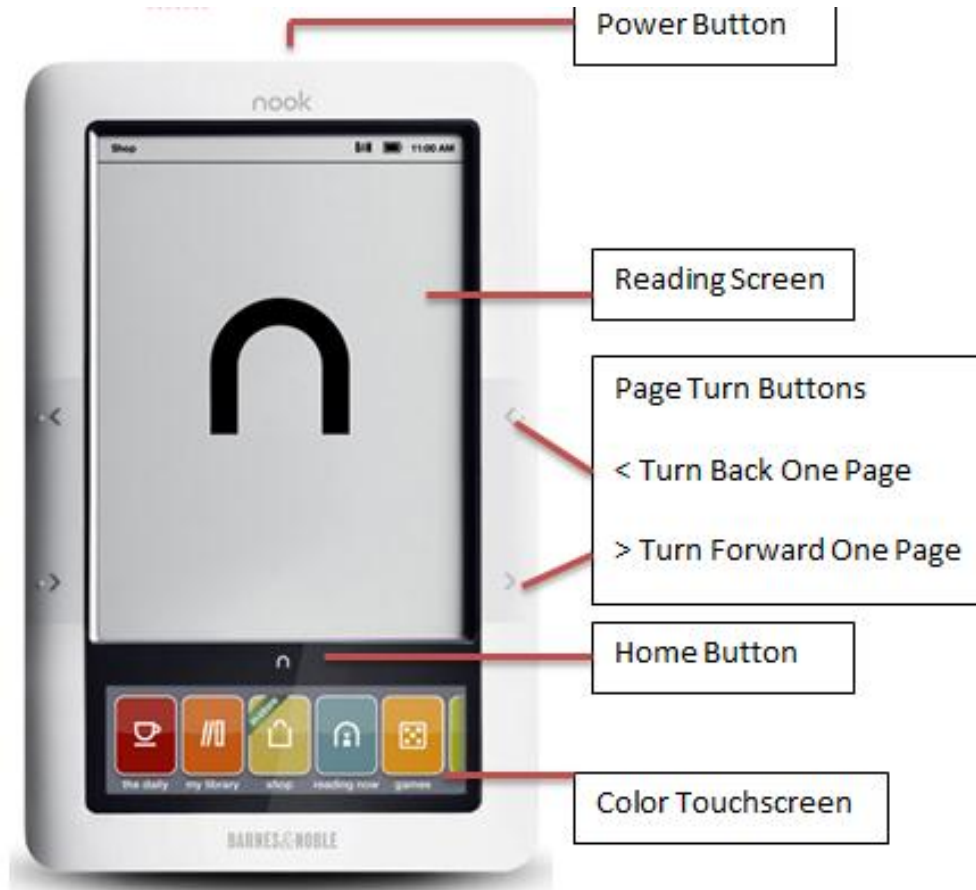

Downloading e-books for the Nook from the library:

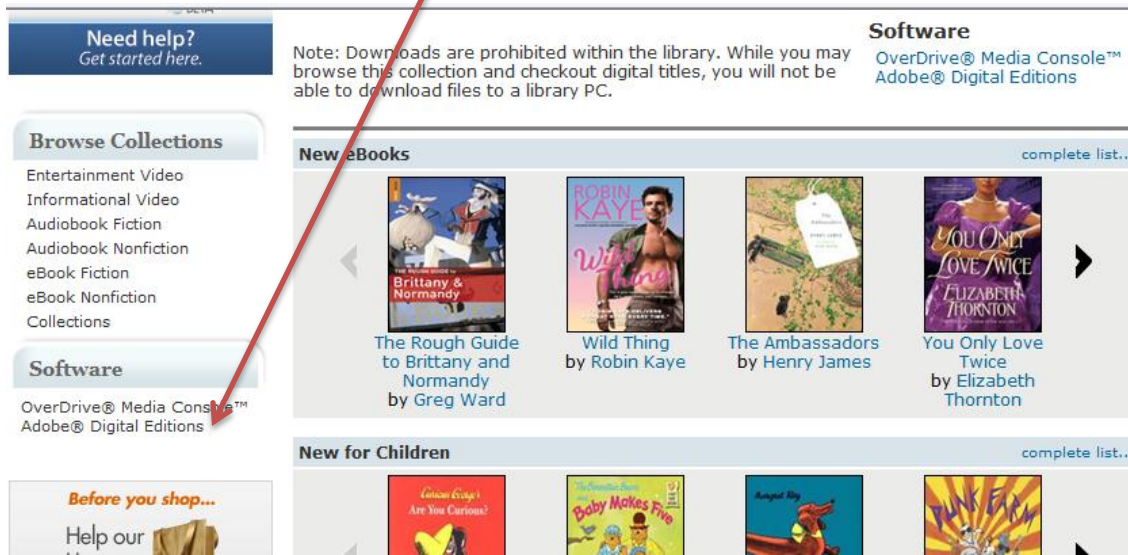
To download an e-book for the Nook, you will need Adobe Digital Editions. This is a free download and registering your copy is completely free. This cannot be done from a library computer.

Step 1: Downloading Adobe Digital Editions

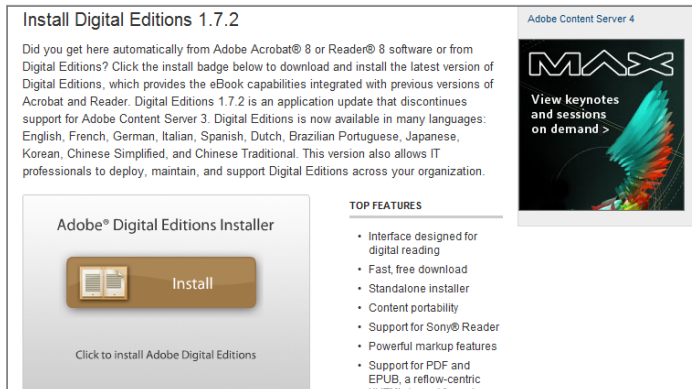
Under Downloadables on the Baldwin Borough Library Website



This will take you to the Overdrive website. Click on the link for Adobe Digital Editions under the tab Software on the left-hand bar



This will take you to the download site for the Adobe Digital Editions Installer which looks like this:



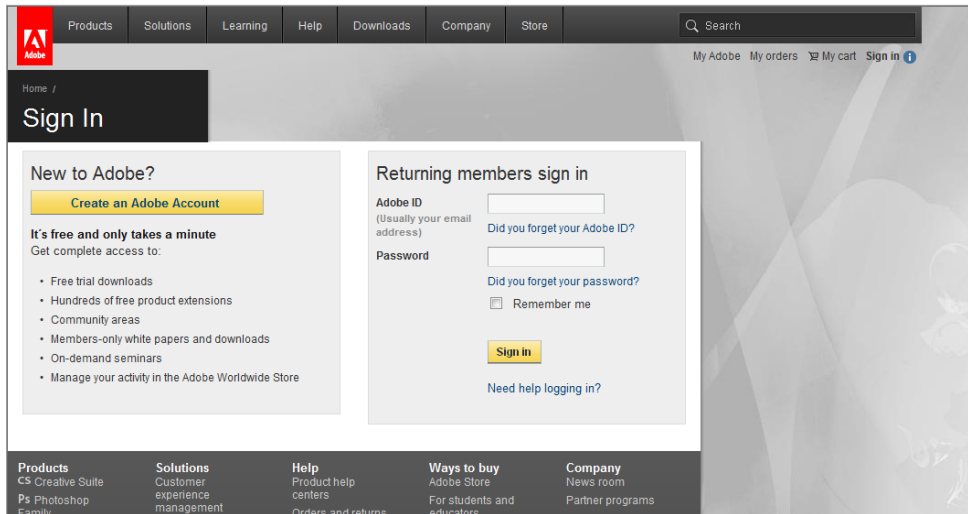
Click on the **Install** button and follow the instructions for downloading

Step 2: Authorizing Your Computer

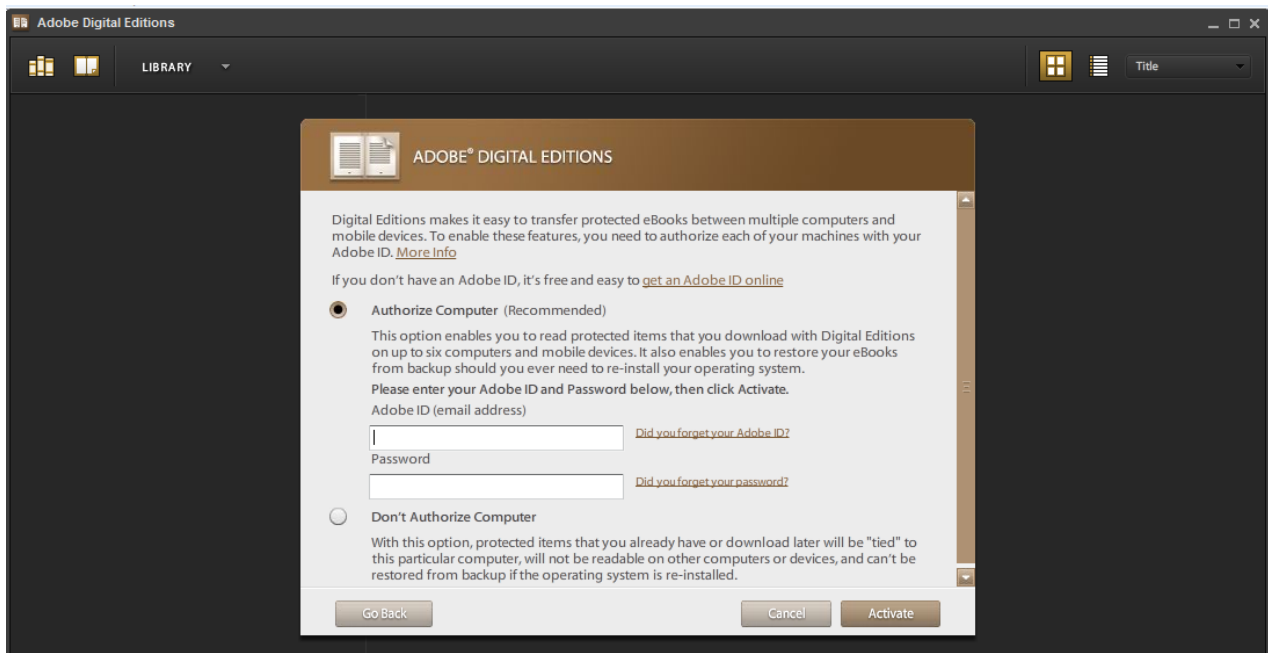
You will need an Adobe Account ID which can be obtained here:

<https://www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm>

Select **Create an Adobe Account** and fill out the starred information. The other information is optional and not necessary to obtain your Adobe Account (note, to create an account is completely free)



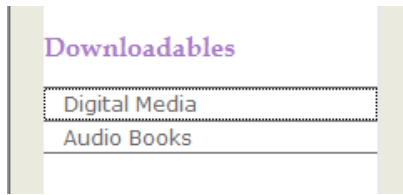
Using this information you will need to authorize your computer in order to read your borrowed books on your Nook. When you open Adobe Digital Editions for the first time, this screen will appear:



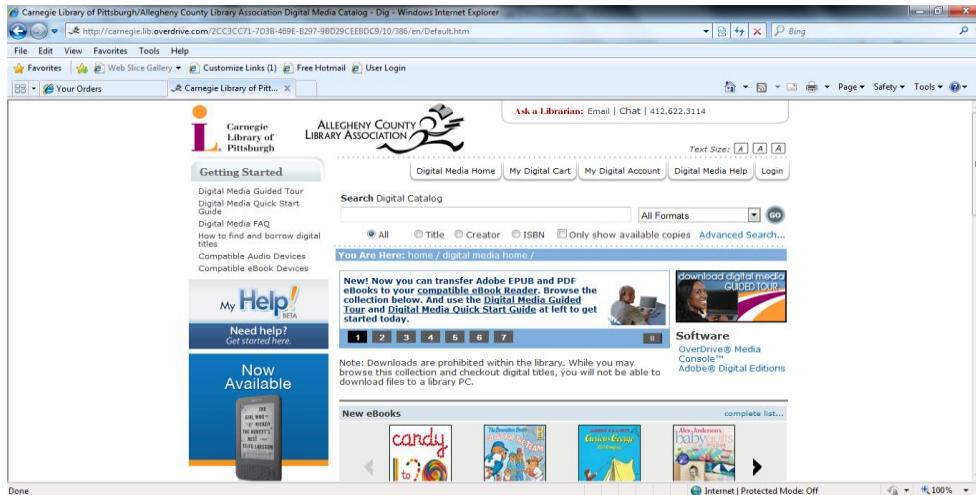
Use the Adobe ID and password that you just registered to authorize your computer

Step 3: Access Overdrive, the digital book repository

Under Downloadables on the Baldwin Borough Website, click Digital Media



The digital book download site looks like this:



Step 4: Select a book.

You can search for an e-book using the search bar. You can limit the e-book format (ex. only Adobe EPUB books) using the drop down menu next to the search bar.

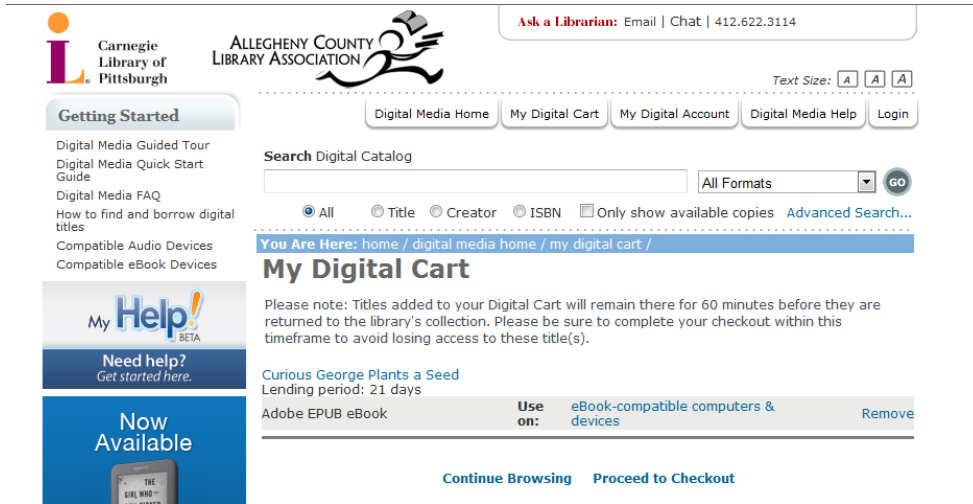
If the book is not check out it will say **Add to Digital Cart**. Only one copy of a digital book can be downloaded at one time. An available digital book page will look like this:



Step 5: Checking out in Overdrive

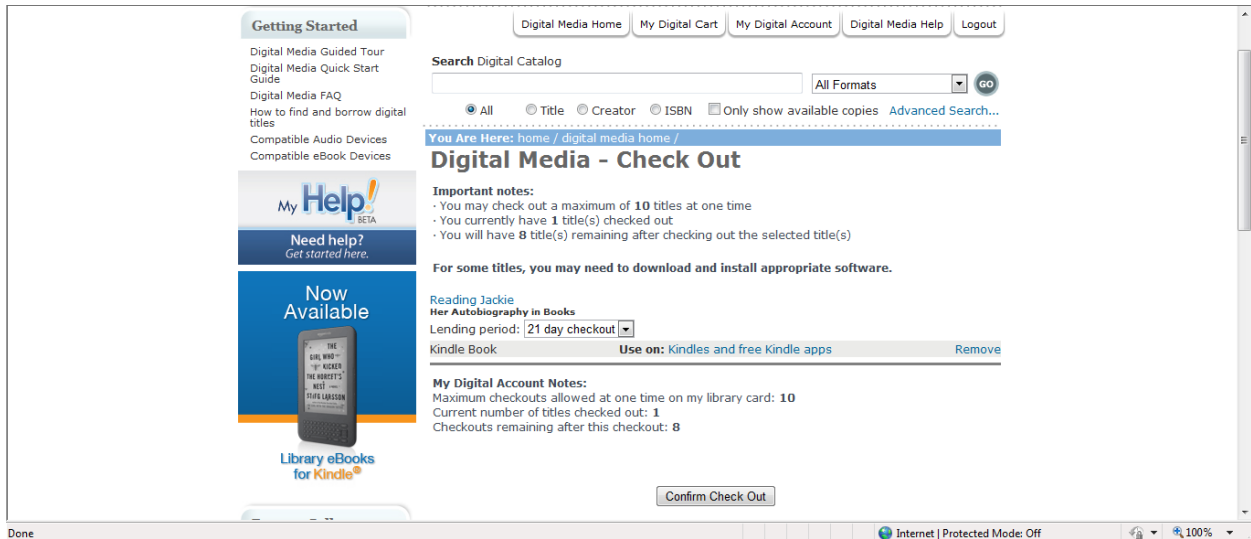
To download an e- book for the Nook, select the **Add to Digital Cart** link next to the Adobe EPUB eBook (or the equivalent)

To check out your book, go to your digital cart which will look like this:



If you are finished selecting books, click the **Proceed to Checkout** button. If not, click on the **Continue Browsing** button

When you checkout, you will need to enter your library card number. The **Checkout Page** looks like this:



Select **Confirm Check Out**

Step 6: Putting your borrowed e-book on your Nook (note, this cannot be done from the library)

The next page will prompt you to download the e-book to your computer. Select the **Download** button

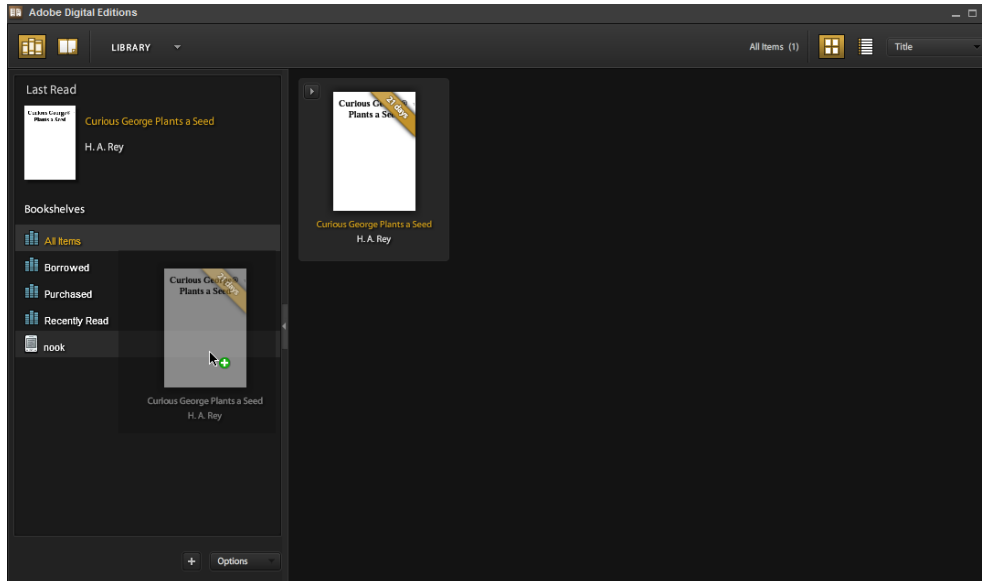

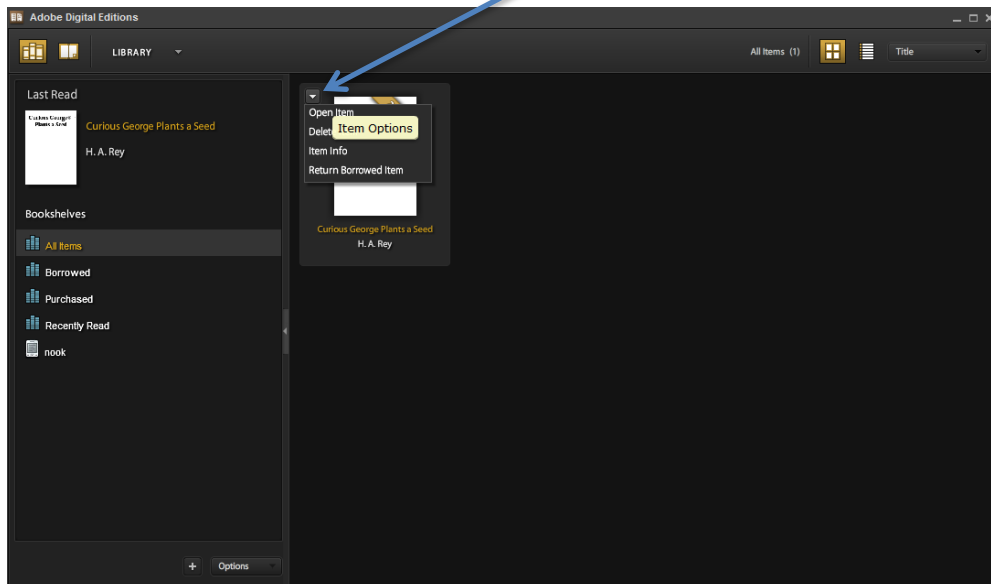
To put your newly downloaded book on your Nook, you will need to connect your Nook to your computer using the provided USB cable. The Nook will then pop up at a tab on Adobe Digital Editions.

Simply drag the icon for your newly downloaded book to the Nook tab on Adobe Digital Editions. A successful drop will show a green plus sign, as seen below. Your book is now available to be read.



Returning a Nook Library Book Early:

To return a Nook e-book early, simply click the down arrow on the book's icon and select Return Borrowed Item
